## BUSINESS AND ECONOMIC SECTOR



### CAREN S. FRANZINI

Ms. Franzini has served as Chief Executive Officer of the New Jersey Economic Development Authority (EDA) since January 1994. The EDA is an independent, self-sustaining state financing and development agency that works to promote economic growth, job creation and the revitalization of New Jersey's communities with financing assistance, technical support and entrepreneurial training, and real estate development activities. She joined the Authority in March 1991 as Deputy Director.

In 2006, under Ms. Franzini's direction, the EDA arranged for \$425 million in financing assistance and \$120 million in business and technology tax incentives that are supporting public-private investments of \$1.8 billion and the creation of an estimated 15,000 new, full-time jobs.

Ms. Franzini serves on the Board of Directors and is the past president of the National Council of Development Finance Agencies. She serves on the Board of Directors for the New Jersey Schools Development Authority, the New Jersey Technology Council, the New Jersey Development Authority for Small Businesses, Minorities' and Women's Enterprises, the Chamber of Commerce Southern New Jersey, and is President of the Corporation for Business Assistance in New Jersey. She also serves on the Board of Trustees of the New Jersey Chapter of the National Association of Industrial and Office Properties (NAIOP), the Southern New Jersey Development Council and on the Advisory Board of the Rothman Institute of Entrepreneurial Studies of Fairleigh Dickinson University.

Ms. Franzini is a past recipient of the Golden Investment Partnership Award presented by the AFL-CIO Building Investment Trust in recognition of her participation in innovative investment partnerships, the John H. Martinson Technology Supporter Award by the New Jersey Technology Council, and the New Jersey Business and Industry Association's Paul L. Troast Award for her promotion of and commitment to improve the state's economy and create jobs. She also has been a recipient of an Advocate Award from the New Jersey Association of Women Business Owners for her work in support of women business ownership and the Distinguished Achievement Award by the Southern New Jersey Development Council for her public sector contributions and leadership to the eight southern counties of New Jersey.

Ms. Franzini holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Urban Studies from the University of Pennsylvania and a Master of Business Administration degree from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania.



## TRENT STAMP

Trent Stamp has led Charity Navigator since its inception in April of 2001. Under his leadership, Charity Navigator has become the nation's largest and most-used evaluator of American charities and non-profits. Nearly five million donors annually use the site that *Time Magazine* called "One of America's 50 Coolest Websites for 2006." Additionally, the site is a three-time Forbes award winner for "Best of the Web," was selected by *Reader's Digest* as one of the "100 Best Things About America," and was chosen by *PC World* as "One of America's Top Sites for 2006."

In his role as Charity Navigator's president, Mr. Stamp appears as a regular expert analyst for The Factor with Bill O'Reilly and CNN. He has provided opinion and commentary for NBC's The Today Show, ABC's Good Morning America, and CBS's The Early Show. He also has appeared on NBC Nightly News with Brian Williams, The Newshour with Jim Lehrer, and Comedy Central's The Daily Show, among others, and served as a contributor to National Public Radio programs Morning Edition and All Things Considered. He has published editorials and articles on charity issues, the role of government regulation in the charitable sector, fund-raising ethics, and non-profit leadership in over 50 newspapers, journals, and magazines, including *The Atlanta-Journal Constitution*, *The Chronicle of Philanthropy*, and *The Los Angeles Times*.

Mr. Stamp is a presenter and speaker at many national conferences and seminars on issues affecting the non-profit sector. He is also the author of "Trent Stamp's Take", a blog about the non-profit sector that was recognized in 2006 by the *Chronicle of Philanthropy* as "One of Ten Non-Profit Blogs That Get Attention." In 2004, he was selected by New Jersey Business Magazine as one of "40 Business Leaders Under 40" in the state and is a 2007 recipient of the Five Sectors Lifetime Achievement Award for his impact as a public servant in New Jersey. He is a member of the Editorial Board of Advisors and regular contributor to *FundRaising Success Magazine*.

Mr. Stamp received his Master's in Public Policy from Duke University and his B.A. in Law and Society from the University of California, Santa Barbara. He is married, with two small children, and resides in Cornwall, New York.



## WILLIAM J. WALSH, JR.

Bill Walsh is the Director of Corporate Issues in the State Governmental Affairs Department of Public Service Enterprise Group (PSEG). The department's responsibilities include representing the interests of PSEG and its affiliates before the executive and legislative branches of New Jersey state government in the areas of energy and public policy, including the development of and advocacy for company positions, as well as the management of external relationships. Mr. Walsh has thirty years of experience in the energy business at PSEG. During his career at PSEG, he has held various positions in electric planning, marketing, rates and load management, performance management, government relations and corporate responsibility, serving there as the President of the PSEG Foundation, before his current position.

Mr. Walsh holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Electrical Engineering and a MBA from Rutgers University. Bill is a lifetime member of Eta Kappa Nu, the National Electrical Engineering Honor Society and is a member of the Leadership New Jersey Class of 1992. He currently serves on the boards of the Robert Wood Johnson Healthcare Corporation at Hamilton, the Home Port Alliance for the Battleship New Jersey and is Vice Chair of the Hamilton Area YMCA.

## EDUCATION SECTOR

**GARY HRYNOWESKI**

Gary Hrynowski's most significant professional accomplishment is the founding of Inverse, Inc. in July 2001. Inverse is a non-profit, community-based organization that serves at-risk children and their families. He has 16 years of experience working with adolescents and their families in New Jersey. Mr. Hrynowski's vast experience, knowledge, and relationships compelled him to establish Inverse with the purpose of *building up and equipping youth for responsible living*.

The first program implemented by Inverse was an Outreach Program providing mentoring to at-risk youth. The organization provides one-to-one mentoring, academic assistance, life skills training and crisis counseling. Inverse is a Medicaid Provider of Intensive In-Community Services and Behavioral Assistance Services for adolescents.

Inverse provides services to youth referred by a school, DYFS, probation, parent, residential facility, therapist or any youth related organization in Hunterdon, Morris, Somerset, Sussex and Warren counties. The organization has provided successful services to clients referred from the TRI County CMO, Morris/Sussex CMO, Warren YCM, Somerset YCM, Morris County CART, Somerset County CART, Warren County CART, Morris County JRC, Morris County JETTS and Somerset County DYFS. Inverse also has contracts with the Department of Human Services in Morris County and Warren County providing services to adolescents on probation.

As the founder and Executive Director of Inverse, Inc. Mr. Hrynowski has established a Board of Directors to successfully guide the organization toward accomplishing its mission while preserving the public trust.

He earned a Bachelors of Science Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from Philadelphia Biblical University in Langhorne, Pennsylvania. He is also a member of the Somerset County Inter-Agency Coordinating Council and member of the Morris County United Way Mentoring Training Program Steering Committee.

**MARK VALLI**

Mark Valli is the founding President & CEO of New Jersey After 3, Inc. New Jersey After 3 is the nation's first statewide public/private partnership created to expand and improve afterschool opportunities. Previously Mr. Valli served as Vice President of New Jersey Community Development Corporation (NJCDC). During his five year tenure with NJCDC, he was responsible for corporate and foundation outreach, representing the agency at various public events, and coordinating efforts with other organizations

on various state-wide initiatives. Before joining NJCDC, he spent six years as one of two founding staff people with the New Jersey Commission on National & Community Service. The State Commission is responsible for funding the state's AmeriCorps programs, which have provided over 2,000,000 hours of structured and supervised community service. Mr. Valli served for 2 years in the Governor's Office under Governor Jim Florio. Finally, he spent 2 years working for a management consulting firm that specialized in non-profit facilities and energy management.

Mr. Valli holds a Masters in Public Administration at Rutgers University and graduated Phi Alpha Alpha. He previously graduated from Swarthmore College with honors in history and political science.

## FAMILY SECTOR



### MARY BAUGHMAN

Until recently, Mary Baughman served for eight years as the Executive Director for Jersey Battered Women's Service, (JBWS), a private, non-profit agency helping Morris County families victimized by domestic violence.

Founded in 1976, JBWS offers a broad range of services, including: 24 hour hotline and emergency shelter; transitional living program, including vocational development; a legal advocacy program; non-residential counseling for victims of domestic violence; children's services; counseling for

batterers; dating abuse prevention programs for students; professional training for those in caring professions; and community awareness education for employee and civic groups. Each year JBWS directly serves more than 1,400 families and educates 12,000 community members.

Under Ms. Baughman's leadership, JBWS launched its model transitional living program, which was featured in "Voices" (a newsletter for the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence, NCADV) and presented at their national conference. In March 2003, Ms. Baughman participated in the NCADV's "Lobby Day" in Washington D.C., presenting information about the success of this program to key staff on Capital Hill. Ms. Baughman was invited to the White House last October, to see President Bush sign a proclamation about Domestic Violence Prevention and unveil the new Family Violence Prevention postage stamp.

Ms. Baughman places an emphasis on leadership development for women and mentors several businesswomen. In 2003, she received the "Rose & Scroll Award" from Morris County's NJ Association of Women Business Owners in recognition of her outstanding contributions to women and her enduring commitment to community service.

Ms. Baughman is a native of New Jersey, with a B.A. in Mathematics from Lycoming College and an M.S. in Statistics from Rutgers University. She currently resides in Bridgewater, NJ with her husband of thirty years. Ron and Ms. Baughman have one son (Mike) who serves as pastor for the North Hunterdon United Methodist Church.



### KEVIN M. RYAN

Kevin M. Ryan, Esq. is the first Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Children and Families and serves as a member of Governor Jon S. Corzine's Cabinet. He previously served as the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services in 2006 and as New Jersey's first Child Advocate from 2003 to 2006.

Before becoming Child Advocate, Commissioner Ryan represented homeless youth at Covenant House in New York City's Times Square, the South Bronx, Newark and Atlantic City.

In 1997, he founded Covenant House New Jersey's Youth Advocacy Center. Over the past ten years, the Center has provided legal services to thousands of homeless youth. He has helped to craft some of the State's most important social legislation, including the Homeless Youth Act, the Family Care Act, the Foster Care Scholars program, the establishment of the Office of the Child Advocate and the legislation creating the new Department of Children and Families. Harvard Law School recognized his work in 2000 by naming him a Wasserstein Fellow.

Commissioner Ryan is a 1989 B.A. graduate of The Catholic University of America and a 1992 J.D. graduate of Georgetown Law Center. He earned his LL.M. (Masters of Law) from NYU Law School in 2000, where he focused on public interest law.

He has taught at Fordham Law School, Seton Hall Law School and Rutgers Law School focusing on Poverty Law, Children and the Law, and Constitutional Law. He is also the author of numerous articles on poverty, children and the interests of families. He and his wife have six children.

## GOVERNMENT AND POLITICAL SECTOR



### RICHARD J. CODEY

Senate President, and former Governor, Richard J. Codey represents the 27th legislative district in Essex County, which includes the towns of Caldwell, Essex Fells, Fairfield, Livingston, Maplewood, North Caldwell, Orange, Roseland, South Orange, West Orange, and part of the City of Newark.

Though he is a lifelong Democrat, Senator Codey has earned a reputation as a skillful leader who brings people together to achieve bipartisan goals. He is known among his colleagues as an independent thinker, and a champion of change to benefit the public good.

After winning his first Senate term in 1981, Senator Codey quickly earned a reputation as a leading advocate for health and mental health issues, consumer protections, public safety, education, and the rights of women, minorities, and New Jersey workers.

After serving three decades in the state legislature, he was elected Senate President for the 211th Legislative Session beginning January 13, 2004. On November 16, 2004, when Governor James E. McGreevey resigned before his term expired, Codey became the Acting Governor of New Jersey. In this role, he created the Office of Inspector General to root out waste, fraud and mismanagement, hired a Special Ethics Counsel to develop a mandatory ethics training program, and worked with the legislature to prohibit campaign contributions by business entities seeking or holding State contracts.

With a commitment toward making health care more affordable, Codey sponsored New Jersey's Health Care Reform Act, positioning New Jersey as the first state to enact significant cost-cutting measures for health care, while protecting quality of care. Codey also helped to establish New Jersey's Charity Care program, which helps hospitals treat uninsured patients. In 2003, Senator Codey played a key role in securing record funding for charity care in the state budget to cover hospital visits for the uninsured and underinsured. Believing that no one should have to choose between paying for prescription drugs and buying groceries, Senator Codey also helped create the state program which provides prescription drug cost assistance for New Jersey's senior citizens and disabled residents.

Codey is a devoted husband and father and resides in West Orange with his wife, Mary Jo, and their two sons, Kevin and Christopher. Senator Codey is a graduate of Fairleigh Dickinson University and is President of Olympic Insurance Agency.

## RELIGIOUS SECTOR



### PASTOR CARLTON T. BROWN

Rev. Carlton Theophilus Brown was consecrated Senior Pastor of Bethel Gospel Assembly, Inc., in Harlem, New York, February 2000. His secular training led him to the fulfillment of his dream in becoming a teacher with the New York City Board of Education. He served in that capacity from 1978 until entering full-time ministry in 1987.

Rev. Brown has served in short-term missions assignments and has served as an international conference speaker. A visionary leader, Rev. Brown has founded Bethel Gospel Global Assemblies under which five churches have been planted with locations in the Bronx, New York; Hackensack, New Jersey; Paterson, New Jersey and Norfolk, Virginia. He expanded Bethel's short-term missions' involvement to include medical missions to countries such as Venezuela, Nigeria and Santo Domingo. In January 2006, Bethel dedicated its 364 acre Harmony Estates Project in South Africa which houses a church, Christian boarding school, Youth Resource Center, and skills training program. Rev. Brown recently estab-

lished the Katrina Strategic Action Commission (K-SAC), a two year commission to strategically reach out to those who desperately need our help in the Gulf Coast states.

Besides giving leadership to Bethel Gospel Assembly, Inc., he also currently serves on the board of Concerts of Prayer of Greater New York, Nyack College Manhattan Center, and the Advisory Board of North General Hospital and is a Clergy Liaison with the New York City Police Department.

Rev. Brown received a BA degree in history from Herbert Lehman College and later pursued postgraduate work at New York University. He is currently enrolled at the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary – New York Center where he is pursuing a Master of Divinity in Pastoral Counseling.

He resides in New York City with his bride of 30 years, Elder Lorna Iona Bell Brown. The Browns have two children, Justin Obinne and Carla Priscilla.

## KEYNOTE SPEAKER



### DAVID BLANKENHORN

David Blankenhorn is founder and president of the Institute for American Values, a nonpartisan organization devoted to strengthening families and civil society in the U.S. and the world.

Mr. Blankenhorn is the author of two books and the co-editor of eight. A 2007 profile in *USA Today* describes him as making “a career of thinking about big issues” and presents the Institute for American Values as “a catalyst for analysis and debate among those with differing views.”

*The Future of Marriage*, Mr. Blankenhorn’s most recent book (Encounter Books, 2007), is described as “powerful and persuasive” in making the case for marriage as the best childrearing institution. It has received praise from more than one opponent as “containing much to admire.” His 1995 book, *Fatherless America* (Harper Perennial) describes how fatherlessness is the leading cause of the decline of child well-being in our society. Touted by the Idaho Statesman as the “bible of the fatherhood movement,” it helped inspire the creation of the National Fatherhood Initiative, a non-partisan organization that promotes responsible fatherhood.

Mr. Blankenhorn’s writings extend beyond the family into the realm of civil society. In 2001, Mr. Blankenhorn was the main author of “What We’re Fighting For: A Letter from America,” which presented America’s core values and made the moral case for the war on terrorism. Signed by 60 scholars, the letter received much attention in the Middle East and Europe, and was described by Carl Gershman of the National Endowment for Democracy as “the most effective initiative to influence opinion in the Arab world since 9/11.”

A frequent lecturer, Mr. Blankenhorn’s articles have appeared in scores of publications, including *The New York Times*, *The Washington Post*, *The Los Angeles Times*, *USA Today*, *First Things*, and *Christianity Today*. He has been profiled by *The New York Times*, *USA Today*, CBS Evening News and other news organizations, and has been featured on numerous national television programs, including Oprah, CBS This Morning, The Today Show, Charlie Rose, ABC Evening News, and C-SPAN’s Washington Perspectives.

Prior to founding the Institute in 1987, Mr. Blankenhorn worked as a community organizer in Virginia and Massachusetts. He served two years as a VISTA Volunteer. A native of Jackson, Mississippi, Mr. Blankenhorn founded the Mississippi Community Service Corps and the Virginia Community Service Corps. In 1977, he graduated magna cum laude in social studies from Harvard, where he was president of Phillips Brooks House, the campus community service center, and the recipient of a John Knox Fellowship. In 1978, he was awarded an M.A. with distinction in comparative social history from the University of Warwick in Coventry, England.

Mr. Blankenhorn lives in New York City with his wife, Raina, their son, Raymond, and their two daughters, Sophia and Alexandra.
